We would like to see more people participate in this program. We have received two grants one \$20,000 for the Fire Dept. Air Packs the other was \$45,000 from FEMA from the flooding to replace Burling Drives tube.

Park building has a new roof, septic, well repair, and insulated. Numerous events are held at the park such as fishing tournament, egg hunt, trunk & treat and craft shows.

Don Rinas asked about the sign operation and why only one person knows how to program the sign. Larry Grell stated Clerk is busy enough and not enough time and not a priority. Don Rinas and Larry Grell discussed salaries of the board. Don Rinas asked several other questions such as reports from the Enforcer, Zoning Administrator and why the permits were not on line. Larry Grell said he will get that done. Don questioned why no financial reports. The reply was come in and asks. Don also wanted to know about job descriptions and the reply was we are still working on getting this done.

Carl Malott stated the Clerk's office was in shambles and I guarantee will be straightened up before I leave office.

Larry Grell stated that 941 taxes were not being done properly since 2014. Now getting better.

Larry Nelson stated how things have improved in the township and we are not the laughing stock anymore and the roads are good and we will get matching funds from the county.

Larry Nelson motioned to adjourn the meeting, motion 2nd by Brian Johnson. Motion carried. Time: 9:16 a.m.


