Call to Order: Supervisor Tim Mester called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Correspondence: Consumers Power will be holding hearings on November 14th and November 16th regarding the new Voluntary Green Pricing programs and an amendment to its Renewable Energy Plan.

Fire Chief's Report: Tim Mester read Fire Chief Dale Rottman report for the month of October. Fire Department had 23 calls from October 1, 2023, to October 31, 2023. Training for the month of November is CO2 and Miscellaneous Equipment. The new rescue 31 suburban for Bentley Twp is in service as of today. The Hurst Jaws of Life Training went very well & the department learned new techniques in extraction on new vehicles. Engine 14 will be scheduled in December to get new tires so it will be in compliance with the NFPA. The New Tanker specs are in after being revised, just waiting for the appointment with Front Line Services so we can move to next phase. Dale thanked our fire department team for helping with a successful Trunk & Treat. Open House on October 21st from 10am to 3pm was successful.

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WWTP REPORT: Andy Gwizdala, Plant Manager, reported on behalf of Infrastructure Alternatives covering the operations, maintenance, and management of Billings Township Wastewater Treatment Facility, along with the collection system. **WWTP REPORT:** This Monthly Operating Reports covers **October 2023.** The wastewater treatment plant performed well during **October** with no monthly NPDES Permit violations. 1.6 million gallons of wastewater was discharged from the wastewater treatment plant and was given full treatment during **October 2023.** The average daily flow during discharge from the wastewater treatment was 50,000 gallons. The maximum daily flow was 57,440 gallons. We had 1 alarm call out this month.

Constable: Liquor inspections were done at the following businesses with no issues: Eagles #3655, Sandy's Market, Nikki's Family Restaurant & Dollar General and Off the Hook Tavern. Wixom Lake Gas and Launch is inactive.

<u>DPW:</u> Jason Kumpelis said he is getting quote from Yeager Asphalt to repair driveway by sign at Billings Township. Also stated he is getting plow ready for winter.

Zoning Board of Appeals: Nothing to report.

Ordinance Enforcement: Sandy Streeter gave a lengthy typed report on all complaints, letters that were sent, citations issued, complaints on hold, complaints resolved, complaints dismissed, and court dates set. 2 new complaints, 8 court cases pending, appeared in District Court on 6 cases in October and 2 pending cases.

Park and Recreation Report: Len Pytlak shared Larry Woodard report on park. Park had two successful food distributions. Trunk & Treat had over 400 children. 19 hayrides trips in the spooky area with 4 scary characters. John Deere tractor will be taken to Crump for Lube, oil, and filter. The park committee recommended Rita Styler be appointed to fill the committee vacancy.

Road Report: Sid Hansen asked board to vote on the 2024 road plan stating the tax dollars are at work.

<u>Commissioners Report/Guest Speakers:</u> Tami O'Donnell, District 3 Gladwin County Commissioner talked about Gladwin County Police Millage passing. Tami said Governor Whitmer passed a Wind and Solar Ordinance which takes effect one year after it is signed.
