Call to Order: Tim Mester called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

Pledge of Allegiance: Tim Mester led the Pledge

Pubic Comments: Keith Popour wanted to know the purpose of this meeting. Tim Mester commented it's the annual meeting and the resolutions for the Billings Township Board Members' Cost of Living. Keith Popour wanted to know about the budget. Tim Mester stated the budget will be at a later date. Tammy York commented on her qualifications for the Treasurer position.

Tim Mester stated resolutions had to be voted on individually. Supervisor 12082025-26-27-1 all opposed 12, in favor 25. Resolution Passed. Clerk 12082025-26-27-2 Jenni Reid motioned to approve Clerks resolution, 2nd by Cindy Whittington. 30 in favor, opposed 7. Resolution Passed. Treasurer 12082025-26-26-3 Cindy Whittington motioned to approve Treasurers resolution, 2nd by Sandy Streeter, in favor 29, opposed 5. Resolution Passed. Trustees 12082025-26-27-4(2) Sandy Streeter motioned to approve the Trustees resolution, 2nd by Paul Hilmer. In favor 25, opposed 14. Resolution Passed.

Supervisor Comments: Tim Mester talked about the Supervisor's vision for the Township, such as a recycling center at the wastewater treatment plant, a walking path along the bridge keeping pedestrians' off the road, a community center, a dock for visiting the cemetery from the water, yard waste center at Park or wastewater treatment plant, walking path at the Park and wastewater plant, developing a Corridor plan, Air B&B's tiny home structures, Veterans help to get back in our community. The township needs volunteers for the road committee, Planning Commission, and Zoning Board of appeals.

Public Comments: Cindy Whittington commented on the work in the community such as the Park Memorial, DPW building at the cemetery and the inside bathrooms at the park. When will the board accept Len's registration, Linda McSweyn explained the process of appointing someone or having an election. Linda McSweyn also talked about needing volunteers.
